Some of the debris included a pallet of lumber, a bag of golf clubs, soccer ball, croquet set, and a large wooden fork. These items made up just a few of the multitude of riff-raff that cluttered the grounds of the zoo and took the guys from Woa Cholena two days to clean up. "I will always be unselfish in service and devotion to the welfare of others", all of us have said these words but the young men of Woa Cholena lived them through their One Day of Service.

## Reminders from the Host Lodge: Alibamu

CVC's need to bring to the January COC:

- 1) Physical arrangements needs list
- 2) Equipment needs list

Lodges need to bring to the January COC:

- 1) 4 flaps for awards
- 2) Firm delegate count assuming \$30 fee - this delegate count may not decrease after January 8, may increase until April 15, no guarantee of a patch after February 1, Alibamu will be ordering patches February 2.
- 3) Firm trading post orders - these orders may not decrease after January 8, but may increase until February 1, Alibamu will be ordering on February 2.

For now assume prices will be similar to 2002 prices

## 2005-2007 Leadership in Service Award

Brothers,

Recently at the 2004 National Order of the Arrow Conference, a new award was introduced. The purpose of this award is to continue to strengthen our ties to councils and communities by encouraging arrowmen to be servant leaders. In order to earn this award one must give eight hours of service in a lodge, chapter, or council service project benefiting a local council or troop. In addition, give six hours of service doing a community project planned and run by the lodge or chapter. The requirements of this award must be completed within a calendar year and service hours may not be rolled over to the next year. So no service hours can be logged until after January 1<sup>st</sup>. This award has three parts to it and is much similar to the Arrowman Service Award. All lodge chiefs and advisors should encourage lodge members to earn this award. It is a great way to give back selfless service to our community, which is an integral part of the purpose of our Order. Lodges are encouraged to use the OA's Lodge Guide to Community Service to aid them with planning community service projects. With so much of our area affected by Hurricane Ivan, it is important that we help our community in its time of need. For more information contact your lodge chief or any of the section officers.
